'Chhanyado' is immensely thankful and indebted to all the protagonists supporting the organization in noble missions.



Bhojanshala (The Mess Room)

• A complete, hygienic meal is served at just Rs.3 per dish to the relatives of patients admitted in New Civil Hospital daily since 1998. Since last 23 years, this token price has not changed even today despite of high inflation and on an average, 600 to 700 people are benefitted each day through this service.





State-of-the-art Healthcare Services

- In 2004, Lokseva Medical Stores was established that offers 20% discount on all branded medicines, 40% to 75% discount on generic medicines and 30% to 50% discount on surgical items. Inaugurated by the then Chief Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji in 2008, Aatmajyoti MRI Centre offers MRI screening at a highly subsidized rate to the needy. BPL patients, prisoners, and Senior Citizens are served free on recommendation of the Superintendent of New Civil Hospital, Surat.
- Maheshwari Dialysis Centre, established in 2010, provides around 28 Dialysis' free of cost daily to the underprivileged.
- Jaymala Path Labs, which commenced in 2011, offers lab tests at 50% concessional rates to the patients.
- **Jivan Jyot Diagnostic Centre** established at Udhana in 2017 has facilities like MRI, CT-Scan, Sonography, XRay, Treadmill Test, 2D Echo, Dental Treatment, Pathology Laboratory, Retina & Glaucoma Operation, Physiotherapy at concessional rate, Free Dialysis and OPD services are offered at a token amount of Rs.50 to Rs.100.



Covid-19 Phase-I & Roti Bank



- 'Chhanyado' established **9 centres with 650 volunteers** to provide kitchen and logistical support in the most affected areas comprising of the poor and migrant labours.
- From 27th March to 31st May, 2020, a total of around 5.5 million comprehensive meals were distributed to these set of people.
- Chhanyado' provided breakfast packets and water to 27,000 stranded migrant workers during Covid-19 Phase-I lockdown at Udhana Railway Station.
- 1300 Roti Collection Centres were established by 'Chhanyado' and 26,000 families participated in this project, contributing over 1,50,000 Chapattis in a day to the underprivileged during the testing times of Covid-19.

Covid-19 Phase-II

- 'Chhanyado' donated 50 Ventipeeps and BiPaps that helps to make breathing easier for patients admitted in New Civil Hospital, Surat and 5 units were issued to Jivan Jyot Hospital at Amroli.
- 2000 grocery kits were distributed by 'Chhanyado' to Class-IV employees and Security Personnel at New Civil Hospital Surat, as well as to the Covid-19 patients who were quarantined at home.







Services during Natural Disasters

 Chhanyado dispatched substantial amount of relief materials during 2001 earthquake in **Kutch**, floods in **Surat** and construction of 20 houses post-flood in **Barmer (Rajasthan)** in 2006, cloud burst in **Uttarakhand** in 2013, flood in **Banaskantha** district in 2017 and during floods in **Kerela** in the year 2018.

Services during Earthquake in Nepal

• Following a massive earthquake in Nepal in 2015, 'Chhanyado' constructed 200 shelter homes named 'Mahesh Awas' for the badly hit people of Nepal and distributed medicines worth Rs.12,00,000 to earthquake victims in association with Lions Cancer Detection Centre and Jivan Jyot Trust, Amroli.



Village Adoption

'Chhanyado' had adopted two tribal villages called Paterkue and Pipalvan in Mandvi Taluka of Surat District. 'Chhanyado' dug wells and installed diesel water pumps for both the villages, and this water is now primarily used for farming purpose, built bridge, and also a Community Hall. A program of 'Samuh Lagna' for tribal girls was also organised.





Welfare for the Disabled in Tribal Area

'Chhanyado' aims to cover 1270 villages in 17 Talukas across 5 districts in South Gujarat, spanning to around 2 million tribal people. Every month, on an average, 30 Prosthetics, Orthosis organs, and 6 to 8 Tricycles and Wheelchairs are distributed. Along with this, around 30 to 35 Hearing Aid Machines are also distributed each month.

Free Education in Tribal Area

• More than 200 tribal students from Grade 6th to 12th are being provided free education with free lodging, boarding, bags, books and uniforms to promote literacy in remote area of Khergam in a non-granted school adopted by 'Chhanyado'.





• 'Chhanyado' serves 25 Kg. nutritious Sheera (Sweet Halwa) on daily basis in Gynaecology Ward of New Civil Hospital, Surat made with pure Ghee and 1.5 Kg. Traditional Vasana Laddus to Pre & Postnatal Mothers. A baby kit with 15 essential items is also given to new mothers for taking care of the newborn.

In line with our mission of 'Affordable Healthcare for all', Surat Manav Seva Sangh 'Chhanyado' now plans to develop a full-_ledged, comprehensive Multispecialty Hospital with the most advanced Cardiac Division and General ICU, NICU with in-house Radiology, Pathology and Diagnostic center, fair-price Medical Store and dedicated Ambulance Services to meet any emergency along with most progressive digital technology. This proposed hospital is one step closer to opening one of the most advanced hospitals in Surat as philanthropist Late Shri Hasmukhbhai Hojiwala family donated 2300 Square Yards of their valuable land at Althan where a significant population belongs to the lower and middle income group. The location has an easy approach to industrial suburb and convenient road connectivity to Bamroli, Vadod and Pandesara making it easily accessible to labourers and workers of the industrial area.

This proposed hospital project is estimated to cost around INR 100 crores, 50 crores for hospital construction and 50 crores for corpus fund to manage operational cost and offer free procedures to the needy.
